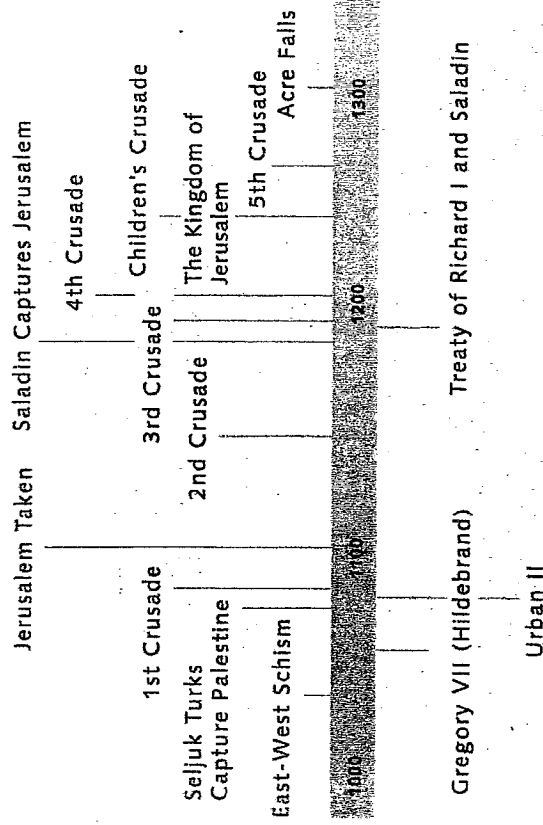


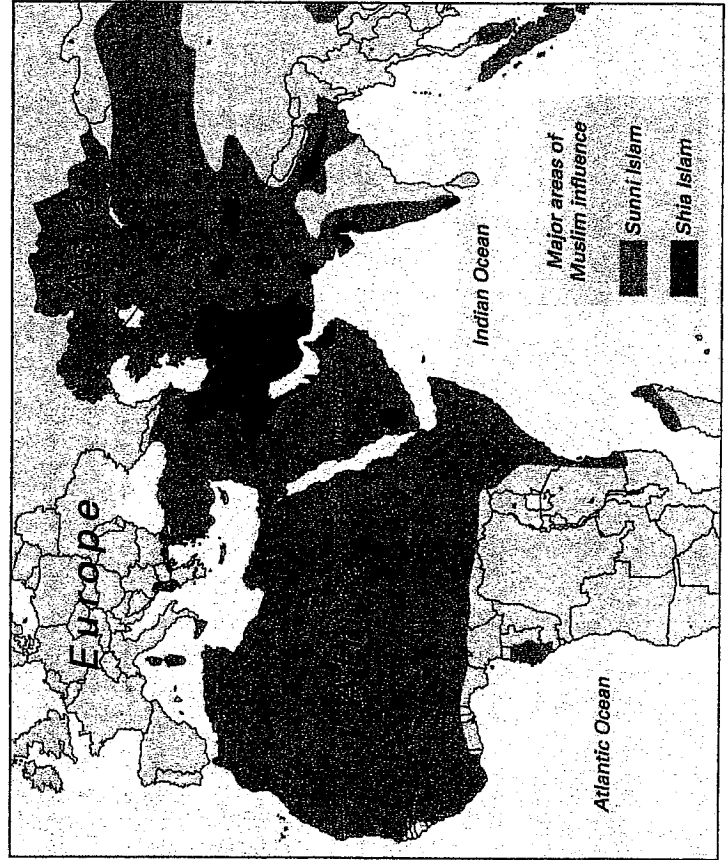
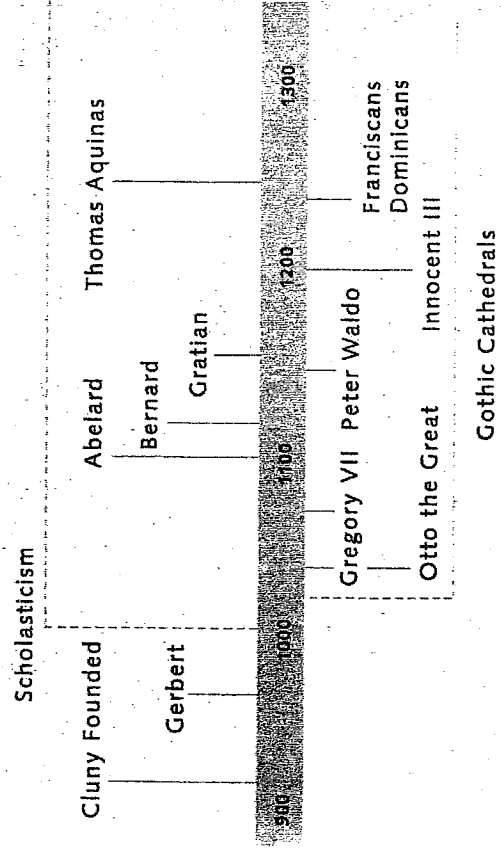

| Name | Dates | Participants | Features |
|------------|---------|---|--|
| First | 1096-99 | Baldwin, Bohemond, Godfrey, Raymond | Captured Jerusalem |
| Second | 1147-49 | Louis VII, Conrad III | Failure |
| Third | 1187-92 | Frederick I Barbarossa, Philip II Augustus, Richard I the Lionheart | Captured Acre and coastal lands |
| Fourth | 1202-4 | Venice | Capture of Constantinople |
| Children's | 1212 | Children | Disaster |
| Fifth | 1217-21 | King John of Jerusalem, Papal legate | Capture and loss of Damietta |
| Sixth | 1228-29 | Frederick II | Failed in Egypt; Jerusalem recovered through negotiation |
| Seventh | 1248-54 | Louis IX | Failed in Egypt |
| Eighth | 1270-71 | Louis IX, Prince Edward | Defeated at Tunis; postponed loss of Palestinian coast |

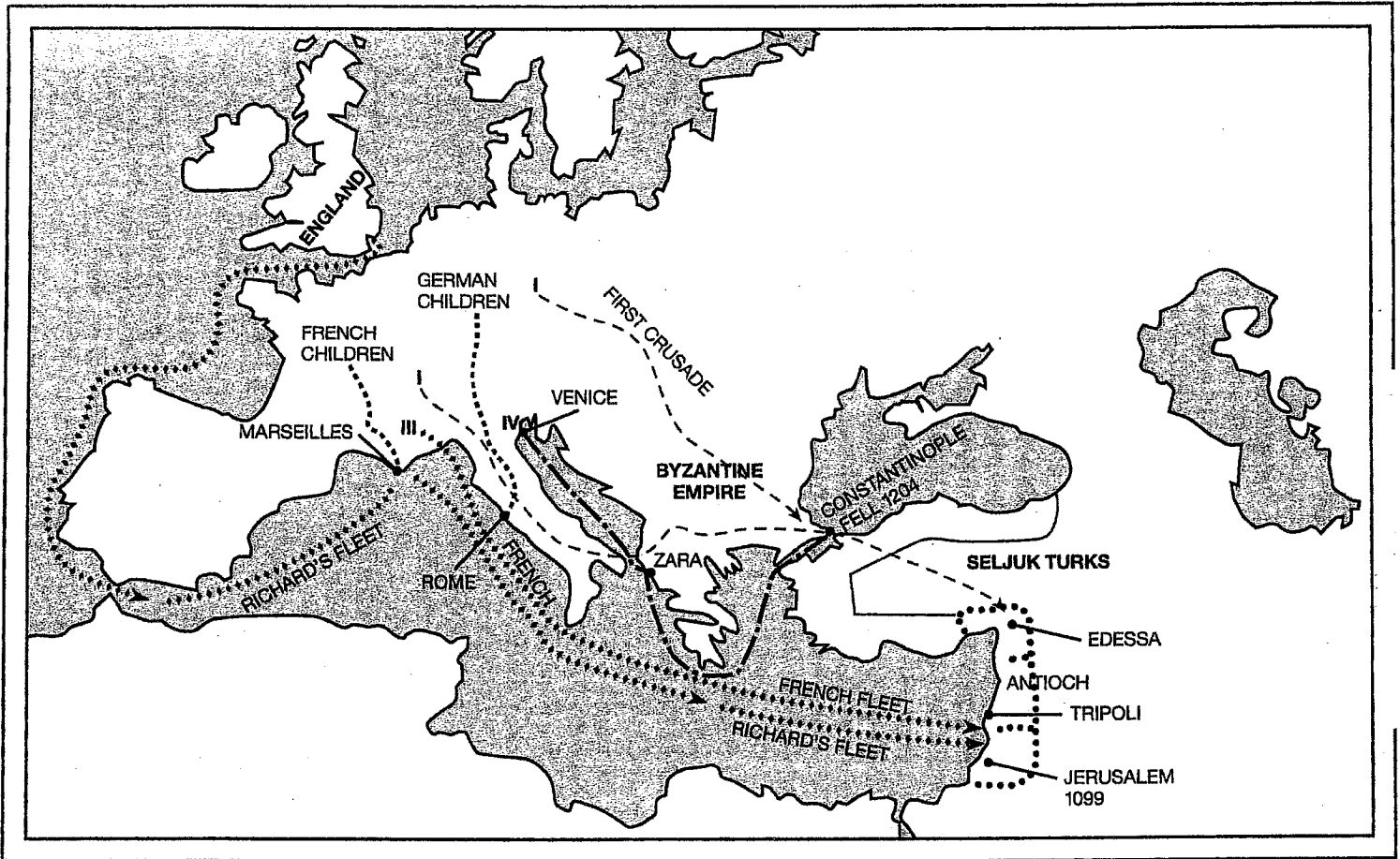

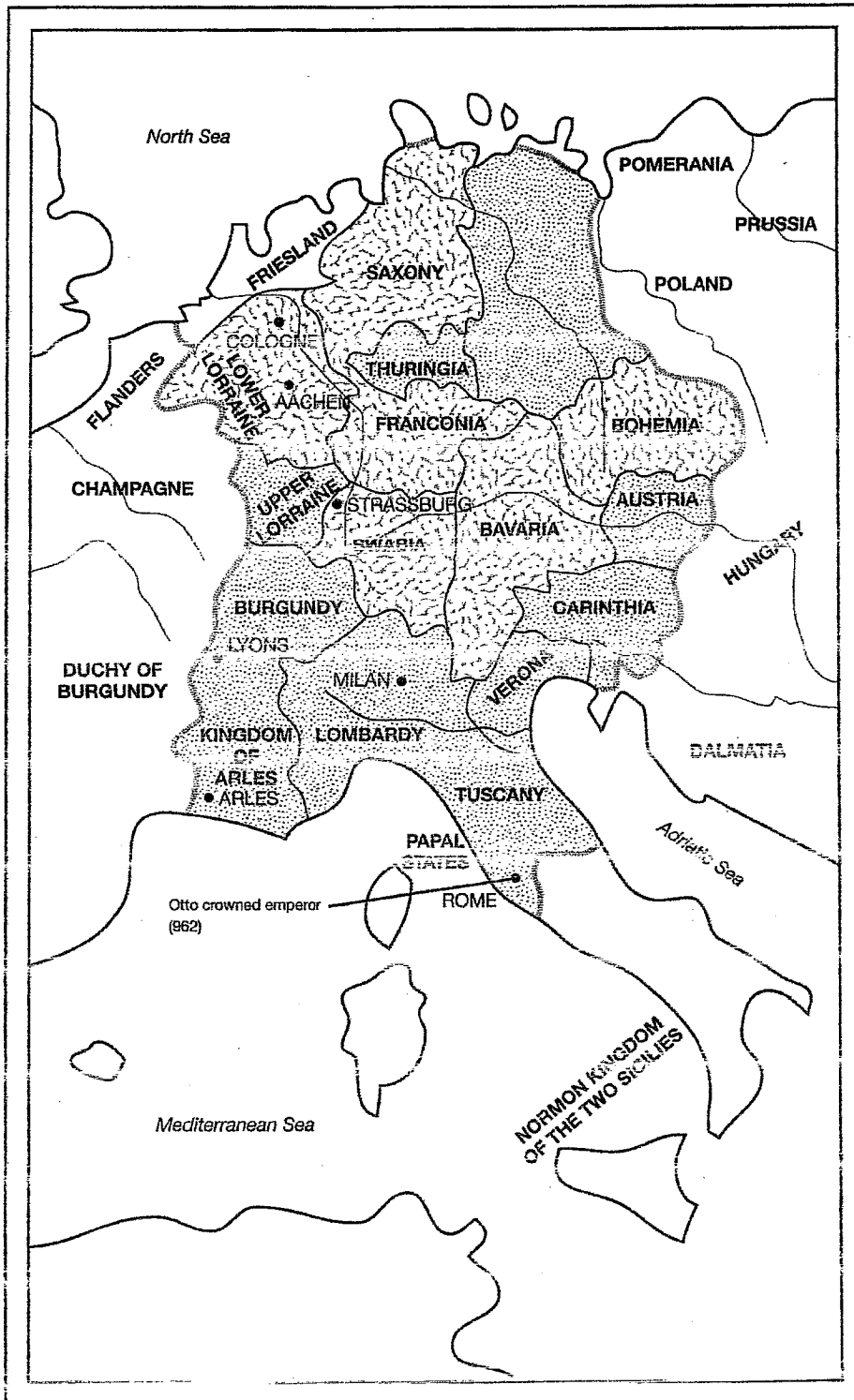
