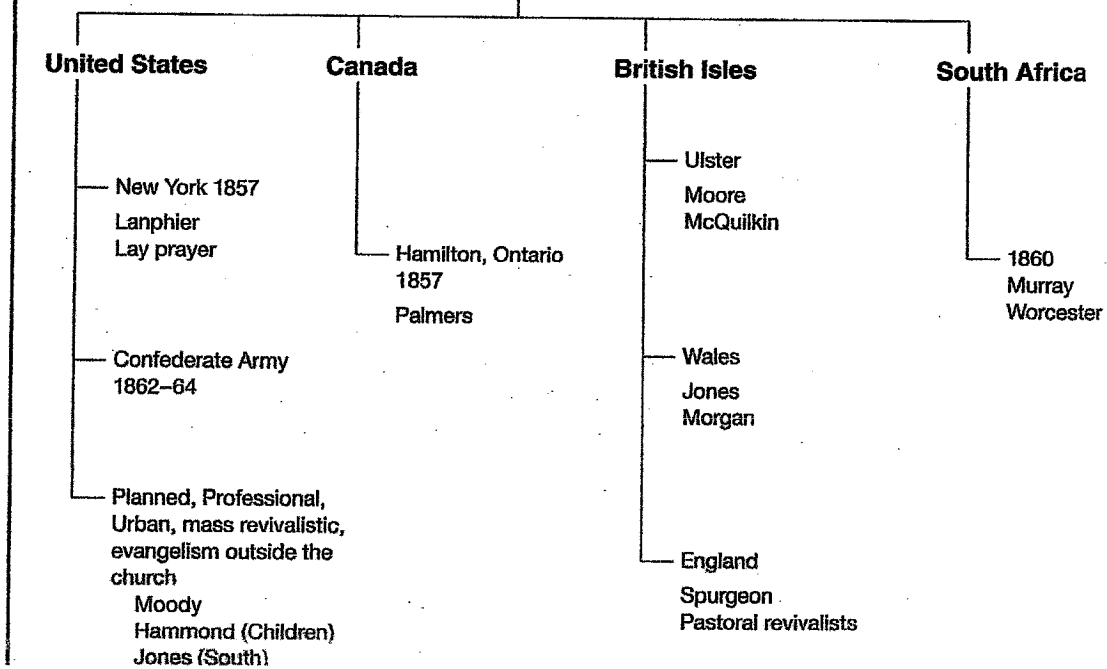
**THE GREAT AWAKENING IN THE THIRTEEN COLONIES, 1726-1756**
