*Why would the
King be crucified?*

1. **God's Love** - John 3:16 *"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."*
2. **God's Justice** – Romans 3:26 *"...so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus."*
3. **Christ's Obedience** – Philippians 2:8 *"And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross."*
4. **Reconciliation** – 2 Corinthians 5:18 *"All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself..."*
5. **Passover Lamb** – 1 Corinthians 5:7 *"For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed."*
6. **Substitutionary Atonement** - Isaiah 53:4 *"But he was pierced for our transgressions..."*
