# Psalm 8

# "How Majestic!"

- 1. <u>Above the Heavens</u> (Glory of God) 1-2 "above the heavens ... out of the mouth"
- 2. <u>A Little Lower than Heavenly</u> (Crowned Man) 3-5 "... what is man ... yet ... crowned"
- 3. <u>All Under His Feet</u> (Works of God's Hands)– 6-9 "you have put all things under his feet."

### Do you let yourself enjoy the moments of awe?

#### And does it lead you to trust in the Lord?

#### 1. <u>Above the Heavens</u> (Glory of God) - 1-2 "above the heavens ... out of the mouth"

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"<sup>14</sup> And the blind and the lame came to him in the temple, and he healed them. <sup>15</sup> But when the chief priests and the scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying out in the temple, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" they were indignant, <sup>16</sup> and they said to him, "Do you hear what these are saying?" And Jesus said to them, "Yes; have you never read, "Out of the mouth of infants and nursing babies you have prepared praise'?" -Matthew 21:14-16

"But when Jesus saw it, he was indignant and said to them, "Let the children come to me; do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God. Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it." And he took them in his arms and blessed them, laying his hands on them." -Mark 10:14-16

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"... what is man ... yet ... crowned"

#### 3. <u>All Under His Feet</u> (Works of God's Hands)– 6-9

"you have put all things under his feet."

"It has been testified somewhere, "What is man, that you are mindful of him, or the son of man, that you care for him? You made him for a little while lower than the angels; you have crowned him with glory and honor, putting everything in subjection under his feet." Now in putting everything in subjection to him, he left nothing outside his control. At present, we do not yet see everything in subjection to him. But we see him who for a little while was made lower than the angels, namely Jesus, crowned with glory and honor because of the suffering of death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone."

"On an appointed day Herod put on his royal robes, took his seat upon the throne, and delivered an oration to them. And the people were shouting, "The voice of a god, and not of a man!" Immediately an angel of the Lord struck him down, because he did not give God the glory, and he was eaten by worms and breathed his last. But the word of God increased and multiplied."

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#### 3. <u>All Under His Feet</u> (Works of God's Hands)– 6-9 "you have put all things under his feet."

"Then comes the end, when he delivers the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule and every authority and power. For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. The last enemy to be destroyed is death. For "God has put all things in subjection under his feet." But when it says, "all things are put in subjection," it is plain that he is excepted who put all things in subjection under him. When all things are subjected to him, then the Son himself will also be subjected to him who put all things in subjection under him, that God may be all in all."
