COLOSSIANS

“This is my covenant, which you shall keep, between me and you and your offspring after you: Every male among you shall be circumcised. You shall be circumcised in the flesh of your foreskins, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between me and you. He who is eight days old among you shall be circumcised.”

- Genesis 17:10-12

“And at the end of eight days, when he was circumcised, he was called Jesus...”

- Luke 2:21

“Circumcise therefore the foreskin of **your heart**, and be no longer stubborn.”

- Deuteronomy 10:16

“And the LORD your God will circumcise **your heart** and the heart of your offspring, so that you will love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, that you may live.”

COLOSSIANS

“Circumcise yourselves to the LORD; remove the foreskin of **your hearts**, O men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem...”

“Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will punish all those who are circumcised **merely in the flesh**”

COLOSSIANS
