1. <u>Opposition</u> – 3:1-2

"how many are my foes ... saying, there is no salvation for him"

1. A Different Reason to Sing: OPPOSITION – 3:1-2

"how many are my foes ... saying, there is no salvation for him"

Who are these many enemies and foes?

- o "in the world you will have tribulation" Matthew 16:33
- o "a person's enemies will be those of his own household" Matthew 16:19
- o "from within, out of the heart of man, come evil..." Mark 7:21
- o "the devil ... is a liar and the father of lies" John 8:44
- o "the last enemy to be destroyed is death" 1 Corinthians 15:26
