“THE RESURRECTED MESSIAH”

JOHN

*“These are written so that you may believe that
Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and
that by believing you may have life in his name.”*

He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent.

For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile to himself all things,

whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross. ...

And you, who were dead in your trespasses... God made alive together with him,

having forgiven us all our trespasses, by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands.

This he set aside, nailing it to the cross.

He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him. ...

If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.

Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth.

For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ.

When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.
