- 1. Wisdom for Suffering without Warning–1:1-5 'Job, blameless, feared God ... greatest of all the people of the east"
- 2. Wisdom for Suffering without Explanation–1:6-12 "The Lord said to Satan, "Have you considered my servant Job"
- 3. Wisdom for Suffering with Worship 1:20 "tore his robe... shaved his head... fell on the ground... worshipped"

1. Wisdom for Suffering without Warning–1:1-5 'Job, blameless, feared God ... greatest of all the people of the east"

Because of the Character of Job, 1-5

Because of the Character of the Disasters, 13-19

JOB 1-2

2. Wisdom for Suffering without Explanation–1:6-12 "The Lord said to Satan, "Have you considered my servant Job"

Because of Job can't hear the Heavenly Court as explanation Because of Job can't find a Human Concept as explanation

JOB 1-2

3. Wisdom for Suffering with Worship – 1:20 "tore his robe… shaved his head… fell on the ground… worshipped"

Because of Job's Perspective - worship

Because of Job's Faith – calls on God

Because of Job's Savior – Jesus' Suffering and Glory
